

The “Photography Release Form” Policy

Leaders and volunteers attending Scouting events are reminded that photography release permission is now included on the Youth and Adult Volunteer registration forms.

Parents and volunteers **must check the box** if they do not wish any photos taken of them or their children to be used in Scouts Canada's publications.

The “Photography Release Form” (for youth and adults) is to be used for special events which involve collaboration between Scouts Canada and an outside agency. It gives permission for Scouts Canada to share images with other organizations for use in their publications and web sites.

This must be used for any such event regardless of whether a parent has checked off the "photo release" box in the registration form.

In the case of photographs of events which are used for Facebook or YouTube purposes, however, Leaders, youth and parents are urged to use discretion and to seek the permission of the individuals before posting their images to the web.
